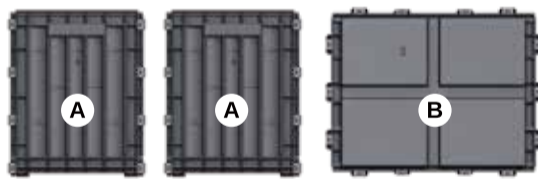

⚠️ MUST DO FIRST:

1. Install the two **Side Panels (A)** onto the **Bottom Panel (B)** first.
2. Ensure the lettered sides of both panels face inward.
3. Not following this order may make assembly difficult and could damage parts.

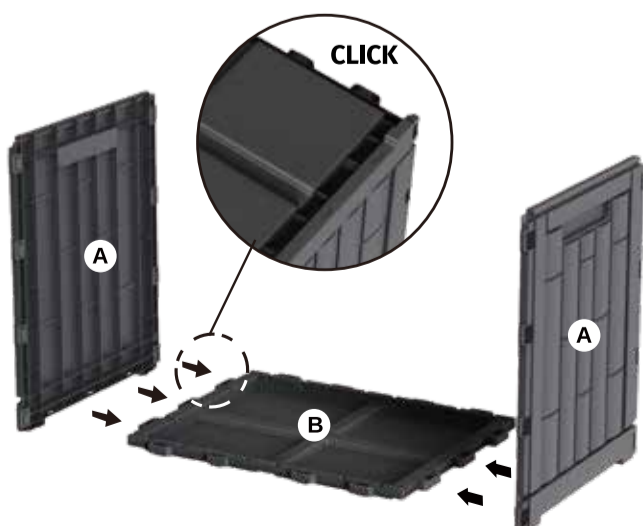
💡 Tips:

printed on the inside of
each panel.



1 Install the Side Panels

1. Align a **Side Panel (A)** with the **Bottom Panel (B)** and insert the tabs into the slots.
2. Press along the edges until all snap locks click into place.
3. Repeat for the other Side Panel (A).

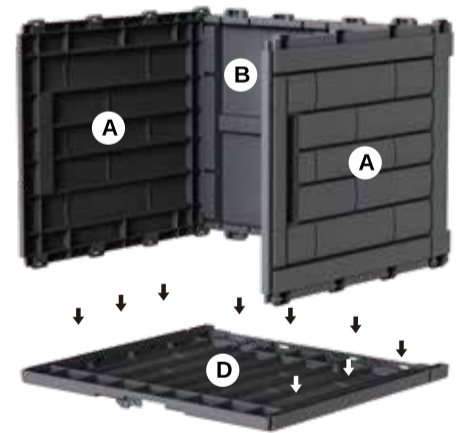


2 Install the Front Panel (D)

1. Lay the **Front Panel (D)** flat with the lettered side facing inward.
2. Flip the A + B assembly over and lower it onto (D).
3. Align the tabs with the slots and press along the edges until all snaps click into place. Use a rubber hammer if needed.
4. Two-person assembly recommended.



Flip the A + B assembly
upside down.

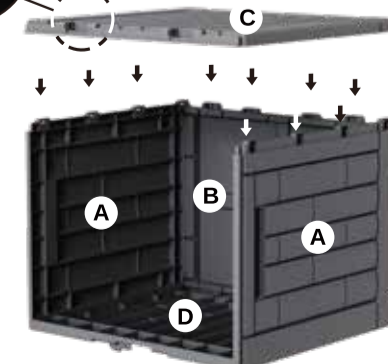

3 Install the Back Panel (C)

1. Ensure the lettered side of the Back Panel (C) faces inward.
2. Align the tabs on (C) with the slots on (A) and (B).
3. Press along the edges until all snaps click into place. Use a rubber hammer if needed.
4. Ensure the latch opening on (C) is at the top and faces outward.

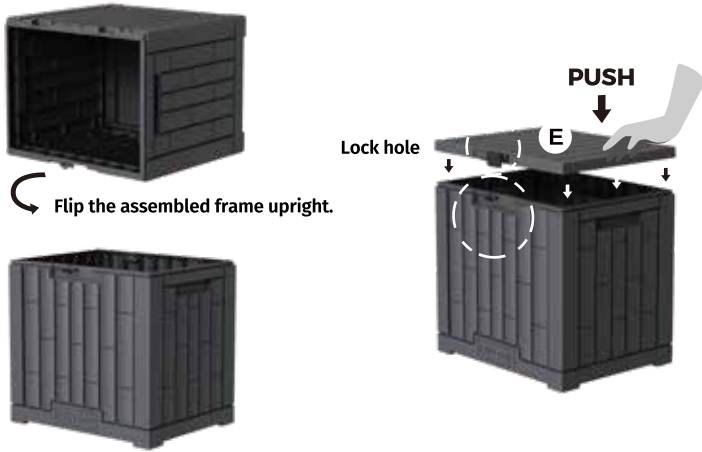
A strong force is required,

4 Install the Lid Panel (E)

1. Ensure the lettered side of the **Lid Panel (E)** faces inward.
2. Align the lock hole on **Lid Panel (E)** with the lock hole on the **Front Panel (D)**.
3. Lower the lid and press along the edges until all snaps click into place.
4. Use a rubber hammer if needed.



5 Finish.

- **CAUTION — Sharp edges:** Some parts may have sharp edges. Wear protective gloves during assembly as needed.
- Assemble on a soft, clean surface (drop cloth or rug) to prevent scratches.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- We recommend using a rubber hammer to assist with installation and fully seat snap locks.
- Letters A–E are printed on the inside of all panels for assembly reference.
- Item identification: For ease of identification, parts are labeled with letters (A–E) that match the steps and diagrams.



CARE & SAFETY

- Avoid placing products in areas with standing water, such as potholes in lawns.
- Ensure all connections and panels are securely tightened before use.
- All parts must be assembled according to the instructions. Do not skip any steps.
- In case of fire, do not attempt to extinguish any burning polypropylene with water.
- Using a stiff brush or abrasive cleaner could damage the box.
- Hot items such as recently used grills, blowtorches, etc., must not be stored in the box.
- After rain, wipe the box with a cloth before opening.
- Not suitable for the storage of flammable or corrosive substances.
- Do not stand on the lid.
- To prevent the risk of suffocation, do not allow children to play inside the box.
- Wear safety goggles and always follow the manufacturer's instructions when using power tools.
