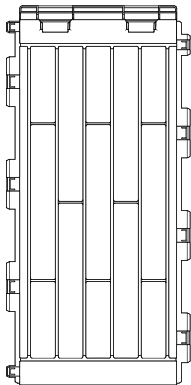

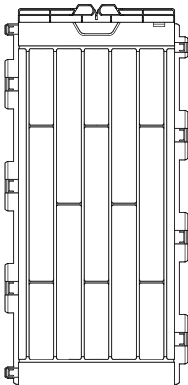

Installation Diagrams



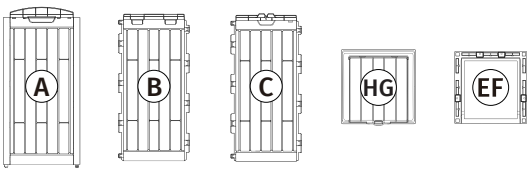
MUST DO FIRST:

1. Ensure the lettered sides of both panels face inward.
2. Not following this order may make assembly difficult and could damage parts.

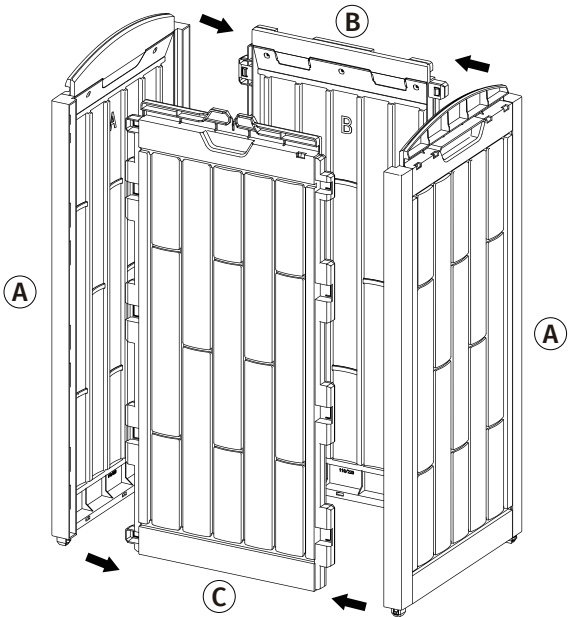

Install the Side Panels (A+B+C)

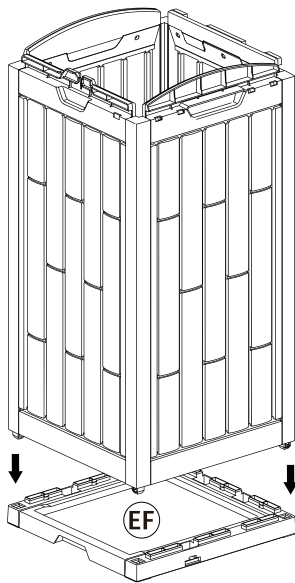
- a. Attach the **Front Panels (C)** and left **Side Panels (A)** as shown.
- b. Attach the **Back Panel (B)** to the left **Side Panels (A)** as shown.
- c. Attach the right **Side Panels (A)**, **Front Panels (C)**, and **Back Panel (B)** as shown.
- d. Press the clips firmly until the panels form a complete ring.

Install the Bottom Panel (EF)

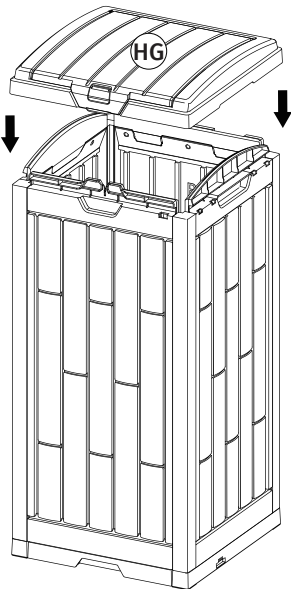
Attach the assembled body onto the **Bottom Panel (EF)**.

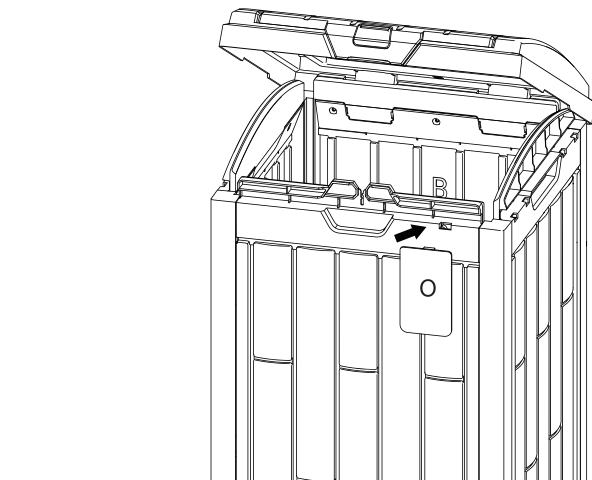
Install the Lid Panel (HG)

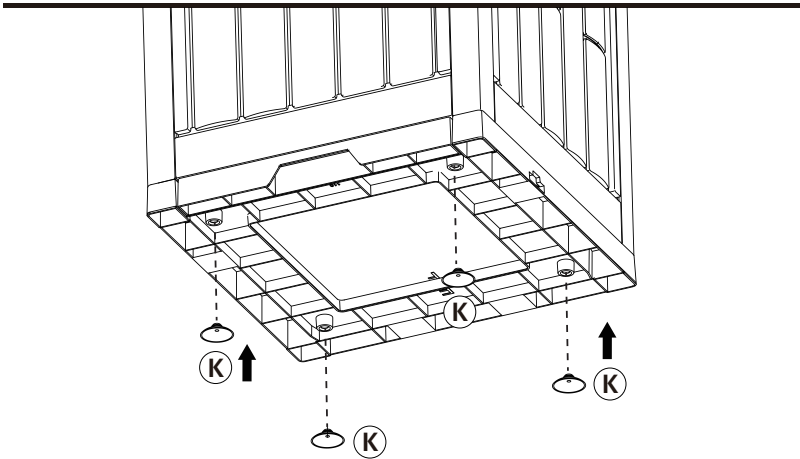

Surface Installation Guide

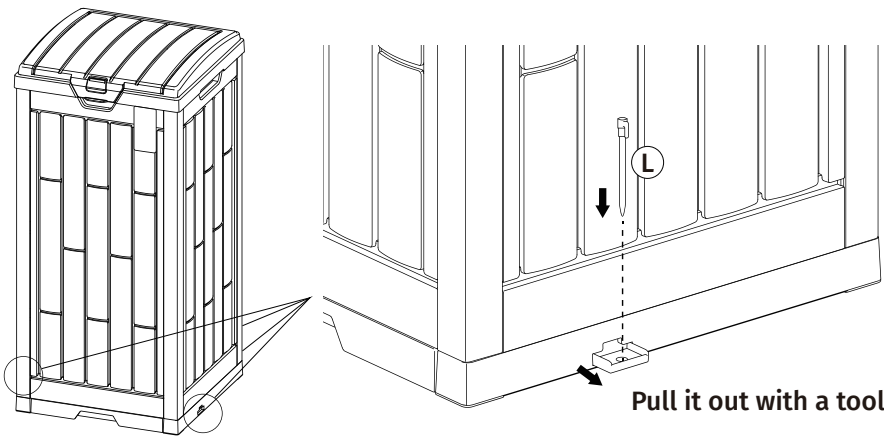

- Part K - For Smooth Surfaces**

Use the **Suction Cups (K)** when placing the trash can on smooth surfaces such as tile or polished floors to prevent slipping.



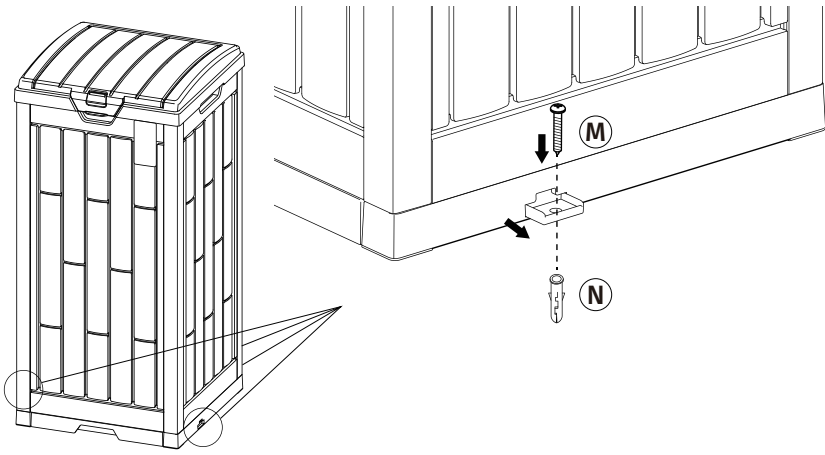

- Part L For Soft Ground**

Use the plastic stakes (**L**) to secure the trash can on grass or soil.



- 7
- Part M & N - For Hard Surfaces**

Use expansion bolts (**M&N**) to securely anchor the trash can on hard surfaces such as concrete or asphalt.

- **CAUTION — Sharp edges:** Some parts may have sharp edges. Wear protective gloves during assembly as needed.
- Assemble on a soft, clean surface (drop cloth or rug) to prevent scratches.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- We recommend Use a rubber hammer to assist with installation and fully seat snap locks.
- Letters A–H are printed on the inside of all panels for assembly reference.
- Item identification: For ease of identification, Parts are labeled with letters (A–O) that match the steps and diagrams.



CARE & SAFETY

- Avoid placing products in areas with standing water, such as potholes in lawns.
- Check all connections and panels for tightness before use.
- It is of utmost importance to assemble all parts according to the directions. Do not skip any steps.
- In case of fire, do not attempt to extinguish any burning polypropylene with water.
- Using a stiff brush or abrasive cleaner could damage the box.
- Hot items such as recently used grills, blowtorches, etc., must not be stored in the box.
- After rain, wipe the box with a cloth before opening.
- Not suitable for the storage of flammable or corrosive substances.
- Do not stand on the lid.
- To prevent the risk of suffocation, do not allow children to play inside the box.
- Wear safety goggles and always follow the manufacturer’s instructions when using power tools.
